NetDimension Announces MatrixEngine 3D Mobile Kit for iPhone

Creates 3D Applications for iPhone and iPod touch Efficiently

TOKYO, JAPAN – NetDimension Corporation announced that the MatrixEngine 3D Mobile Kit for the Apple iPhone will be released on December 21, 2009.

The MatrixEngine 3D Mobile Kit enables designers to quickly create 3D content and applications for the iPhone and iPod touch without programming.

The Mobile Kit is an optional product for the MatrixEngine SDK 2D/3D authoring tool (for enterprise) and DigitalLoca 4U (for individual non-commercial use).

The MatrixEngine 3D Mobile Kit for iPhone accelerates iPhone development projects and reduces costs by enabling designers to put their ideas into action.

Several of the notable features of the MatrixEngine Mobile Kit are its export capability which enables you to create a runtime file for iPhone on the MatrixEngine SDK, and a library which enables you to create an iPhone application with the iPhone SDK.

Beginning in Spring 2010, the School of Informatics at University of Tsukuba will use the MatrixEngine Mobile Kit for its Technology Expert Development Program, Embedded Campus OJT, for iPhone application development.
